MILWAUKEE, WI - The Churchill Society of Wisconsin has been established as an affiliate of the International Churchill Society of Washington, DC to educate new generations; of the leadership, statesmanship, vision, courage and boldness of Sir Winston Churchill.

The CSW was organized early last year by local businessmen, James T. Barry, III, Randall D. Crocker, Johan C.R. Segerdahl, and Stacy G. Terris.

Headquartered at the historic Milwaukee Club in downtown Milwaukee, The Churchill Society of Wisconsin is one of 40 affiliates worldwide recognized by the International Churchill Society.
